Thespians or students earning points to become Thespians are responsible for filling out the point sheets and placing them in the Thespian Binder under your alpha tabs. The binder is located in Ms. Blake's office. You do not fill-in the amount of points you receive. Ms. Blake will do that using the International Thespian Point Guide. You may update your point sheet at any time. Thespian Meetings are a great time to update point sheets! It takes 10 points to be inducted as a Thespian (1pt. Equals 10 hours of service) and it takes 20 points to letter in Theatre or Technical Theatre.
